A few weeks ago I met up with Dawie Botha one of the agents for Nano Works, as I was curious about the potential of using Anti Cor on my carbon steel knife blades, as rust is normally an issue for some customers.

I had an old knife made from a file on my bench that had been there for years, Dawie sprayed some Anti Cor on the blade and then asked me to give it a test.

So the next day I took the blade and wiped it clean, with no visible signs of oil on the surface on the blade, I half submerged the blade in normal tap water, 8 hours later not a mark or discoloration on the surface of the steel.

I then decided to increase the corrosion test and added a large amount of salt to the water again with the blade half submerged in water, after 2 hours still no mark or discoloration on the steel.

The blade was then stabbed through some old cardboard 10 times and put back in water, after 2 hours the blade showed up some minor discoloration on the cutting edge.

I'm truly impressed with the results of Anti Cor, for avid knife enthusiasts and collectors who sometime put blades in the safe or leave in a bag or in the car without having to worry about rust on carbon steel blades, Nano Works - Anti Cor is the way to go.
